ORDER



S.R.O. (I) / 2010.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950), the Federal Government is pleased to direct that in the Import Policy Order, 2009, in paragraph 5, in clause (A), in sub-clause (iv), in second proviso, for full stop at the end a colon shall be substituted and thereafter the following third proviso added, namely:-

‘Provided also that this ban shall not apply to the import of processed or cooked poultry products from China, subject to the certification from the competent authority in China to the effect that-

- (a) poultry commodity or product has been processed at not less than 70⁰ C (Degree Celsius) for reasonable time length throughout manufacturing or cooking of the product to ensure the destruction of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI)(H5NI) virus; and
- (b) raw material for said processed poultry commodity or product has originated from Avian Influenza free zone or area or compartment and processed or cooked in an approved establishment registered with competent authority of exporting country.”
